


Combatting human trafficking in








# A Wonderful Offer

Being a Christian isn't based on membership in a local church or keeping a set of rules or standards. It involves a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and an understanding of who He is and what He has done to provide each of us with a way to experience God's love for ourselves.

Here is how to know Jesus Christ as your personal Savior:

- 1. Realize that you are sinful and separated from God (*Romans 3:23; Isaiah 53:6*)
- 2. Recognize that the penalty for your sin is death eternal separation from God and all that is good. (Romans 6:23; Hebrews 9:27)
- 3. Understand that Jesus Christ took the penalty for your sin by dying in your place and that He rose again. (Romans 5:8; 2 Corinthians 5:21)
- 4. Receive the free gift of salvation by trusting in Christ alone as your Savior. (*Romans 4:4-5; Ephesians 2:8-9*)

You can use this prayer to express your decision to God: "Dear God, I know that I am a sinner. I believe that Jesus Christ died on the cross for me and rose from the dead. I trust in Him alone as the only way to get right with You. Thank You for the forgiveness of sins and the eternal life I now have. Amen."
